The Song of the Lord

Restoration

“The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying:

“Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!””
Rev. 4:8

As the Father reveals His heart to us we join in with all of heaven in the song of the Lord, singing “Holy, Holy, Holy, is the Lord God Almighty” because we have received MORE REVELATION of Who He is and His love for us!

The song of the Lord comes from a place of victory from your heart to God!

This is true worship and the key to true worship is to speak it; proclaim it; sing it!

Restore!

“For I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds,’ says the Lord...” Jeremiah 30:17

Restore:

To render, i.e. to fit, sound, complete

To mend (what has been broken or rent), to repair

To complete

To fit out, equip, put in order, arrange, and adjust

To fit or frame for one's self, prepare

Ethically: to strengthen, perfect, complete, make one what he ought to be

I will restore - to health = wholeness in God.

Be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might.

To be restored looks like this:

A soul that has been wounded or crushed, healed.

Someone that was lost is found.

Someone that went wayward came home.

Something that was taken away and now given back.

Like those who had to leave their land and finally gets to go home.

It's like a soldier who finally gets to go home.

It's like a captive that receives freedom.

A sick person made well.

The impossible made possible.

Those who had things stolen restored 7 fold.

Those who lacked and were empty and now are being filled and have abundance.

Like those who had fallen into sin and are now restored through repentance.

Relationships being restored in God.

Marriages restored in God.

Men and women and children, one generation, loving the Lord with all their hearts, soul, mind and strength.

Peace – nothing missing, nothing broken.

Strength and endurance.

Perseverance and a steadfast love.

Overcoming.

Amen.

How do you sing the song of the Lord?

The believer simply opens their mouths and gives praise to God from your heart! This is true worship.

We all have a song! It is prophecy. It is the testimony of Jesus.

Who will sing?

Who will open hearts and their mouths day by day and just sing to the Lord?

Lies:

‘We don’t sing; we are not worship leaders; we don’t play an instrument, etc.’

Truth:

We are ALL vessels of honor sent to worship and praise our God: we can speak it and sing it.

Holy Spirit may give you a tune or a rhythm and a run.

You may hear the sounds of heaven because your spirit is one with Christ.

Prayer turns unto a song unto the Lord; prophecy turns into a song unto the Lord.

Who will release their heart and open their mouths?

A song of thanksgiving!

Are you singing?

Are you prophesying?

Are you proclaiming His goodness?

Holy Spirit comes with you and releases the word but we are the one God uses to speak and sing!

Have you decided recently to learn to play a new instrument? Now God is adding an instrument to your song? Holy Spirit has prompted you in that. Get instruction if needed.

Let the little children come to me!

Children love to sing; love to dance!

“Forget dancing like no one is watching. Dance like a toddler. They don’t even care if there is music.”

Are we as adults too sophisticated?

Have we gone beyond that?

The Lord's New Song of Restoration [Part 3]

Deliverance from Deep Dark Caverns of Pain and Captivity

I will be speaking and testifying about a love story of a VICTORIOUS KING – OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST - COMING TO RESCUE HIS BRIDE - HIS CHURCH.

I will speak of two open visions given by Holy Spirit to me, in my personal journey and on behalf of His bride that I have been called to serve. These visions are given in due time and season as the Spirit moves and leads the church into the Lord's heart and purposes for the hour.

Both visions deal with regions where the bride has found herself captive and in need of deliverance and revelation.

Jesus is the SAVIOR, THE KING, THE ONE, a JEALOUS BRIDEGROOM who HAS COME. Holy Spirit reveals His heart to His beloved. ISA. 49, 51, 53, 58, 61

While in prayer and worship one morning at my house years ago here in San Angelo, I was worshipping to Misty Edward's song, "Until the Day Breaks", and in the middle of that worship, the Holy Spirit gave me an open vision.

A City of Desolation

I heard the sound horses 'footsteps' first and felt the ground tremble from those sounds and before me was a vision of a great procession of angels in full battle array with multi-colored banners and flags and war like weapons, coming in before KING JESUS, and behind Him. It was a royal procession! I had never seen anything like it before. There was such VICTORY and JOY in the procession. KING JESUS was in full royal attire! He was KING! There was absolutely NO question to His authority.

He and His royal escorts came to a region, a territory, that looked like a 'dry and weary land' that had been bombed and wiped out! I saw remains of some buildings and deep pits that people were coming up and out of from the ground. People were wearing tattered clothes and were wounded deeply from the destructions.

As JESUS came close and arrived to the 'scene'; He dismounted His powerful, strong, muscular, white majestic horse and went straight to the people. He extended His hand to those who were coming up out of the pits and He was helping them all and tending to them with such care and love and compassion. I saw Him go to a woman who was coming out of this pit and her clothes were all shattered and torn and He took off His Kingly garment robe and put it on her! He wrapped it around her with such love and compassion. He was a KING and had come to His people to RESTORE and HEAL.

Holy Spirit took me to Psalms 24 and I found myself agreeing with heaven as I declared in power and joy, the Lord's heart from His word:

And be lifted up, you everlasting doors!

And the King of glory shall come in.

Who is this King of glory?

The Lord strong and mighty,

The Lord mighty in battle.

Who is this King of glory?

The Lord of hosts,

He is the King of glory.

This month, I had found myself speaking of a place in my own heart that I had referred to as a 'deep, dark cavern of pain'.

Dependent upon God to do the impossible in our midst, I run to the cross and choose to die to self and all my needs, wants and desires and choose take up the cross again in order to receive resurrection power.

“With man it is impossible, but with God all things are possible.” Matthew 19:26

“I have been crucified with Christ, and it is no longer I who lives, but Christ who lives within me and the life that I live, I live by the faith of the Son of God who died and gave Himself for me.” Gal. 2:20

“I will restore you to health and heal you of all your wounds, says the Lord of Hosts.” Jer. 30:17

Jealous calls out, “walk with Me in white!” Rev. 3:4

Jesus - Faithful and True

Revelation 3:14; 19:11; 22:6

While in prayer last Sunday night, the Holy Spirit gave me an open vision.

Matt – Illustration of Vision

I saw a 'region of captivity' = a plain before me with a 'deep dark cavern'. I was standing in front of this region, looking at it before me.

I was on the ground level, yet could see it all as if above it.

The land was dry and plain and there were no trees. There was a huge 'cavern' that went throughout the earth from the place I was standing and as far as I could see. Within this 'cavern' I saw so many people, trying to climb up the walls of the earth trying to make it to the top and they were extending their hands up as if for someone to take their hands and pull them up and out. I thought of the multitude of souls that needed to be saved at this moment, but knew these were not 'lost souls', these were God's people trapped in a region of captivity.

I saw Jesus appear before and above them. He was looking upon them with such compassion and love and mercy. He was HIGH AND LIFTED UP and deeply concerned of their captivity. He was above the landscape, not standing

on the ground. He was the center of the vision. HIS NAME IS FAITHFUL AND TRUE. Angels appeared in front of the Lord and above the great cavern watching the people, as if they were ready to bring them up and out. Yet, it was if they were waiting for an order a command to 'go and pull them up and out!'

A Cavern of Deep Dark Pain = wounds of the heart within and with others; persecution; how long oh Lord; battles; battle scars; tragedies; losses; deep pain - physical, spiritual, emotional; powerless Christians in despair; mortal wounds.

Who will shout, “RESTORE!”

Look upon FAITHFUL AND TRUE

1. The way to come out of this cavern is the way of the cross:

John 3:14, 15

"And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life."

John 12:32-33

"And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself." This He said, signifying by what death He would die."

CHOOSE TO SING HIS PRAISE THE SONG OF THE LORD

2. Jesus was high and lifted up! He must be worshipped and lifted above ALL CIRCUMSTANCES AND ALL PAIN AND ALL HEARTS!

His desire is to RESTORE!

EXCHANGE OF SELF FOR LOVE

3. The child of God must choose the way of the cross, 'death to self' in order to come up and out of the cavern. It is at the cross where Jesus is VICTORIOUS and HIGH AND LIFTED UP over all! Mercy and grace are found in the face of Christ and His face is towards all. To come up and out of the cavern of deep pain one must choose by HIS OWN WILL to die by giving all the pain to Jesus as He bore it already on his cross for us. We must willfully choose to die with Him, give up ALL that is in that pain, denying self and choosing to LOVE and be as CHRIST HIMSELF in any and all situations. Next, now that the will has surrendered ALL, then the WILL of the child of God must be to come up and out of the cavern. Once this decision is made, by the grace of God,

He will climb right up and out the top of that cavern and heavenly assistance is there to pull them up and out!

“On that day Deborah and Barak son of Abinoam sang this song:

“Israel’s leaders took charge, and the people gladly followed. Praise the LORD!

“Listen, you kings! Pay attention, you mighty rulers! For I will sing to the LORD. I will make music to the LORD, the God of Israel. “LORD, when you set out from Seir and marched across the fields of Edom, the earth trembled, and the cloudy skies poured down rain. The mountains quaked in the presence of the LORD, the God of Mount Sinai— in the presence of the LORD, the God of Israel. “In the days of Shamgar son of Anath, and in the days of Jael, people avoided the main roads, and travelers stayed on winding pathways. There were few people left in the villages of Israel—until Deborah arose as a mother for Israel. When Israel chose new gods, war erupted at the city gates. Yet not a shield or spear could be

seen among forty thousand warriors in Israel! My heart is with the commanders of Israel, with those who volunteered for war.

Praise the LORD!

*“Consider this, you who ride on fine donkeys, you who sit on fancy saddle blankets, and you who walk along the road. Listen to the village musicians gathered at the watering holes. They recount the righteous victories of the LORD and the victories of his villagers in Israel. Then the people of the LORD marched down to the city gates. **“Wake up, Deborah, wake up! Wake up, wake up, and sing a song! Arise, Barak! Lead your captives away, son of Abinoam!**”* Down from Tabor marched the few against the nobles. The people of the LORD marched down against mighty warriors. They came down from Ephraim— a land that once belonged to the Amalekites; they followed you, Benjamin, with your troops. From Makir the commanders marched down; from Zebulun came those who carry a commander’s staff. The princes of Issachar were with Deborah and Barak. They followed Barak, rushing into the valley.

But in the tribe of Reuben there was great indecision. Why did you sit at home among the sheepfolds— to hear the shepherds whistle for their flocks? Yes, in the tribe of Reuben there was great indecision. Gilead remained east of the Jordan. And why did Dan stay home? Asher sat unmoved at the seashore, remaining in his harbors. But Zebulun risked his life, as did Naphtali, on the heights of the battlefield. “The kings of Canaan came and fought, at Taanach near Megiddo’s springs, but they carried off no silver treasures. The stars fought from heaven. The stars in their orbits fought against Sisera. The Kishon River swept them away— that ancient torrent, the Kishon. March on with courage, my soul! Then the horses’ hooves hammered the ground, the galloping, galloping of Sisera’s mighty steeds. ‘Let the people of Meroz be cursed,’ said the angel of the LORD. ‘Let them be utterly cursed, because they did not come to help the LORD— to help the LORD against the mighty warriors.’ “Most blessed among women is Jael, the wife of Heber the Kenite. May she be blessed above all women who live in tents. Sisera asked for water, and she gave him milk. In a bowl fit for nobles, she brought him yogurt. Then with her left hand she reached for a tent peg, and with her right hand for the workman’s hammer. She struck Sisera with the hammer, crushing his head. With a shattering blow, she pierced his temples. He sank, he fell, he lay still at her feet. And where he sank, there he died. “From the window Sisera’s mother looked out. Through the window she watched for his return, saying, ‘Why is his chariot so long in coming? Why don’t we hear the sound of chariot wheels?’ “Her wise women answer, and she repeats these words to herself: ‘They must be dividing the captured plunder— with a woman or two for every man. There will be colorful robes for Sisera, and colorful, embroidered robes for me. Yes, the plunder will include colorful robes embroidered on both sides.’

“LORD, may all your enemies die like Sisera!

But may those who love you rise like the sun in all its power!” Then there was peace in the land for forty years. Judges 5 NLT

Haggai 1-2 – Build My House for My Glory

Understanding Haggai [Prophet of God who spoke to the Jews the same time as the prophet Zechariah]

God’s people, the Jews, had once again disobeyed God and rebelled in their hearts and went after other gods to worship them. The Lord gave them over to enemies as He sent them into exile in Babylon. [587BC] A few years later, King Cyrus [King of Persia] defeated Babylon [537BC] and he chose to release the Jews to go home to Judah and rebuild their temple [approx. 52 years of captivity].

The Jews had made the foundation and altar for the temple but stopped the work due to their enemies. So for several years they just took care of themselves and their own houses and did not finish the temple for God.

The Word of the Lord came through Haggai the prophet to finish building the temple.

Zerubbabel the governor and Joshua the high priest and the remnant of the people choose to obey the voice of the Lord their God.

The fear of the Lord was upon all.

After they chose to obey in the fear of the Lord, the Lord speaks. “I am with you, says the Lord.”

The Lord stirs the spirits of the leaders and the peoples and they immediately came and began to work on the house of God.

Israel’s Deliverance from Egypt

God’s people, Israel, were delivered out of 400 years of slavery and bondage in Egypt. Believers in Christ Jesus were delivered from Satan and the bondage of sin through Jesus!

“Moses said to the people, “Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. “The LORD will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace.” And the LORD said to Moses, “Why do you cry to Me? Tell the children of Israel to go forward. “But lift up your rod, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it. They sank to the bottom like a stone.

Exodus 15:22-27

Once Israel continued on their journey through the wilderness they encountered bitter waters. The people complained to Moses about the water.

God had Moses throw a tree into the water and they became sweet!

Deliverance = bitter waters = then people complain = then God brings Mercy and the tree of life and Holy Spirit cleanses us from bitterness, doubt, unbelief.

“I am the Lord who heals you.” God is still the God who heals!

12 wells and 70 palm trees

Rivers of living water = Holy Spirit = within us He pushes up and out those old patterns, poisons, bitterness, and sins from Egypt.

John 7:38, 39

“He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living waters. But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive.”

A Song of Moses – Prophecy over Israel

Moses 120 years old

Deuteronomy 31

Do not fear or be afraid of your enemies. The Lord your God is with you. Let’s believe it!

The law of God was given and the law was to be read, sung, declared and repeated to the peoples and families and children and great grandchildren etc. The testimonies of God were shared in the same way so all would remember! The Lord was to be feared and the law and His word was to be obeyed.

The Lord told Moses, they are coming into the promised-land, and then they are going to forsake God and serve other gods and break covenant with God.

“Write down this song as a witness for ME.”

“This song will be a witness against them.”

Moses wrote the song and then taught it to Israel.

Deuteronomy 32

The Song of Moses that spoke what was and would be and would come in the latter days.

Moses exalts the Lord first and gives Him high praise before He continues.

Remember the testimonies and signs and wonders from God among the people.

He is Jealous and rebukes them for their stiff-necks and rebellion of heart and disobedience. A nation void of counsel. He speaks of His judgments towards Israel. God surrendered them to their enemies.

God establishes WHO HE IS. Vengeance is the Lord's.

Thus saith the Lord!

Deut. 32:21

“They have provoked Me to jealousy by what is not God; They have moved Me to anger by their foolish idols. But I will provoke them to jealousy by those who are not a nation; I will move them to anger by a foolish nation.”

Deut. 32:43

“Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people;

For He will avenge the blood of His servants,

And render vengeance to His adversaries;

He will provide atonement for His land and His people.”

God is saying I am going to extend my borders now and go outside of My family Israel to the peoples that are not Mine – oh Gentiles oh heathens! I am going to make atonement for you and for My people and My land.

Moses was to view the land of promise that Israel will inherit!

Moses was not allowed to enter the Promised Land due to his disobedience. The LAW could not inherit the promises, because of sin in our hearts, no one would ever be able to obey God perfectly in heart and will. The LAW could not inherit the promise. Moses represented that LAW. GRACE had to come through Jesus Christ as He alone was able to fulfill the law thus obeying it perfectly and provide inheritance through those who believe in Him.

It is by GRACE through FAITH that we are saved.

Worthy is the Lamb!

This song was a prophecy of what was to come for the Jew, Gentiles and nations!

The Song of the Lamb

Revelation 5

*“And I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a scroll written inside and on the back, sealed with seven seals. Then I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, “Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?” And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it. So I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it. But one of the elders said to me, “Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, [Jesus] has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals.” And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth. Then He came and took the scroll out of the right hand of Him who sat on the throne. Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. And **they sang a new song**, saying:*

“You are worthy to take the scroll,

And to open its seals;

For You were slain,

And have redeemed us to God by Your blood

Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,

And have made us kings and priests to our God;

And we shall reign on the earth.”

Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice:

“Worthy is the Lamb who was slain

To receive power and riches and wisdom,

And strength and honor and glory and blessing!”

And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying:

“Blessing and honor and glory and power

Be to Him who sits on the throne,

And to the Lamb, forever and ever!”

Then the four living creatures said, “Amen!” And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives forever and ever.”

This is the song of the Lamb! The Lion of the tribe of Judah. The promised Messiah! The promised One. Jesus – a Jew! He fulfilled the LAW perfectly. The Law was not abolished but fulfilled. He did it for us! He made atonement.

He is the One. He would pay the wrath of God; the punishment; the vengeance; upon Jesus that Moses prophesied!

Everyone sings this song – in heavens, on earth, and under the earth! Every tongues confesses and knees bow that Jesus is Lord!

Revelation 15

The song of Moses and the Song of the Lamb

The prophetic songs of Moses spoken by God are now fulfilled and all worship is given to the Lamb.

“Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous: seven angels having the seven last plagues, for in them the wrath of God is complete. And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God.

They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying:

*“Great and marvelous are Your works,
Lord God Almighty!
Just and true are Your ways,
O King of the saints!
Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name?
For You alone are holy.
For all nations shall come and worship before You,
For Your judgments have been manifested.”*

After these things I looked, and behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened. And out of the temple came the seven angels having the seven plagues, clothed in pure bright linen, and having their chests girded with golden bands. Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever. The temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power, and no one was able to enter the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed.”

The Father poured out His wrath on Egypt, Pharaoh! Again, God’s judgments poured out upon His enemies, the wicked. Angelic hosts carry this out. Before the throne of God the saints appear in VICTORY AS OVERCOMERS OVER SATAN BY THE BLOOD OF THE LAMB AND THE WORD OF THEIR TESTIMONY LOVING NOT THEIR OWN LIVES EVEN UNTO DEATH.

*Though the wrath of God is going to be poured out, the saints are singing this song because it is a fulfillment of the songs of Moses and the song of the Lamb.
All fully fulfilled in Christ.*

*The nations come in! Israel is saved and will be saved. The land is God’s forever.
King of the saints! King of Glory!*

All nations will come and worship. Every instrument in heaven; every angel in heaven; every saint; every nation will be singing the song of the Lamb!

We win. Your word Lord, is FAITHFUL AND TRUE!
